Solara Congratulates Aviator Wayne Maynard on Solo North Pole Flight

WINNIPEG, MB – 29 July 2010 – Solara Remote Data Delivery Incorporated congratulates solo aviator Wayne Maynard on achieving his North Pole flight on 27 July in his modified Columbia 350 aircraft in support of the Grace Flight charity.

Mr. Maynard carried a Solara Field Tracker 2100 device on his intrepid flight to provide Iridium Satellite 2-way Tracking, Emergency Monitoring and Text Messaging. Solara is very pleased to have been selected for this flight.

The 10-day, 7,000 mile (11,000 km) flight is a mission to raise funds and generate awareness of Grace Flight of America. The mission of Grace Flight of America is to help people in need of free air transportation for medical and humanitarian purposes. Mr. Maynard, 61, of Dallas, Texas, became involved with Grace Flight when his brother-in-law, Dr. Jack Bolton, was diagnosed with esophageal and stomach cancer in 2009. After flying his brother-in-law Jack and sister-in-law Terri home from Houston's MD Anderson following treatment, Mr. Maynard decided to donate his time to helping other patients.

The Solara Solace Direct monitoring software system was also being used to monitor the flight for any Alert messages triggered by the Alert Emergency switch on the Field Tracker 2100. In the event of an Alert, Solara Solace Direct immediately presents details of the Alert to a monitoring station operator, with immediate presentation of the identity of the distress caller, their location, and any pertinent information on contacts and their trip. The operator then continues a 2-way exchange to determine the reason for the Alert and takes action appropriate to the circumstances, including alerting rescue personnel.

Solara is proud to have been selected to provide tracking and emergency alert notification on Mr. Maynard's flight.
